Read and understand instructions completely before assembly. Determine the front of each unit to be ganged. Some units are symmetrical from front to back.

1. Turning the furniture units upside down will simplify assembly. Typically, the bracket with the slot (A) should be attached to the unit that will be on the left.

Place bracket (A) on unit as shown. The front of the bracket should be 9.5" from the front, lower edge of the unit. Use the locating tool (C) to help determine this measurement. Mark the location on the unit, if needed.

Remove any existing screws that would interfere with the location of the bracket.

2. The inside edge of the slot should be aligned with the side of the unit as shown.

Attach the bracket to the unit using (3)#10 Screws (D). **Do not overtighten screws.**

Typically, the bracket with the tab (B) should be attached to the unit that will be on the right.

3. Place bracket (B) on unit as shown. The front of the bracket should be 9.5" from the front of the unit. Use the locating tool (C) to help determine this measurement. Mark the location on the unit, if needed.

Remove any existing screws that would interfere with the location of the bracket.

4. The outer face of the tab should be flush with the side of the unit as shown.

Attach the bracket to the unit using (3) #10 screws (D). **Do not overtighten screws.**
